



TRAVEL AND COVID PROTOCOLS

Effective Date: 11/20/2020

All individuals entering Gulfstream Park, Gulfstream Park West or Palm Meadows properties must:

- Submit to a daily temperature check
- Use 6-foot social distancing
- Wear face covering over nose and mouth at all times
- Report any symptoms immediately

Effective immediately, no jockeys or agents are allowed on the backside of any of our facilities. Starting with the Championship Meet, jockeys are required to wear face coverings during the races.

Anyone on property who fails to follow the protocols puts racing in jeopardy and may be subject to fines and have access to the facilities terminated for the remainder of the Fall & Winter meet.

The following information outlines the protocols for travel, symptoms, exposure and positive Covid-19 tests.

Horsemen Protocols

Trainers, Exercise Riders, Grooms and other non-jockeys

In Florida for 14 days or more - nothing is required, as long as there are no symptoms and no exposure to anyone with Covid-19.

If coming to our properties (from within the U.S.) **or coming from another Florida track/training center:**

- Provide a negative result of a PCR nasal swab Covid-19 test that was administered within 5 days of arrival (rapid test not accepted); have no symptoms or known Covid-19 exposure; present negative test result for access to backside areas. (may be presented at security gates or emailed in advance)

If travel by commercial airline (from within the U.S.)- in addition to the above, *also required:*

- On the 8th day of being in Florida, take an approved Covid-19 test; provide copy of boarding pass from flight to Florida and the negative test result for continued access to backside areas.

International arrivals:

- Those who have traveled outside of the United States in last 14 days, or who are arriving directly from a foreign country, will be managed on a case-by-case basis.
Contact racing management prior to travel as **Pre-authorization is required**.



Covid-19 Symptoms, Exposure and Positive Test Protocol

All individuals who have been, or plan to be, at any of our facilities are responsible to inform the company within 24 hours if they develop any symptoms, are exposed to Covid-19 or test positive for Covid-19. In most cases, individuals must remain off property for 14 days and follow advice from their personal medical provider. If an individual resides on Company property, they will be instructed on how to quarantine, but at no time should they engage in work activities or be near others. In all cases, the company will provide instructions on how to get clearance to return to normal activities on a case-by-case basis.

Anyone with a prior positive Covid-19 test should have it placed on record with the company to avoid any false positive tests going forward.

Trainers are responsible to verify their employees are symptom-free every day and that all protocols are followed. Trainers may be required to arrange for testing of their team members from time to time, and the company will provide information to assist in those circumstances.

Rapid Covid-19 Molecular Nasal Swab

*At FastCare, Appx \$150 – not covered by insurance
Results 15 minutes in clinic*
